

Junior Dairy Goat Auction Rules

2010 Sale

1. Each Exhibitor may sell only one dairy doe. Selling this animal **will not** affect status in the Junior Livestock Auction.
2. The doe must be an American or Purebred, born not before December 1st of the year prior to the sale, and not after March 31st of the sale year. **Doelings must be by a ADGA recognized Star or Plus buck or out of a Star doe.**

Additional Rules

3. Each youth may enter up to 2 (two) does with the understanding that only one doe will sell, and the final declaration as to which doe will sell, must be declared at the CAE testing clinic.
4. The youth member will see that the doe is dehorned, permanently identified, and CAE Negative.
5. Members must own the does for at least 120 days prior to exhibiting at the Junior Dairy Goat Show, during the Humboldt County Fair.
6. Project information form, project agreement form, sellers agreement/bill of sale form, and a copy of the registration papers or registration application **must be mailed to** Humboldt Dairy Doe Replacement Project, Attention Deborah Silva, PO Box 93, Ferndale CA 95536 and **must be post marked by April 30th**. Forms will be accepted up until the CAE testing date with a \$25.00 late fee. Does without the above items will not sell.
7. Project does must be entered and shown in the Humboldt County Fair in the division provided for auction does.
8. Does must be tattooed prior to CAE testing clinic.
9. CAE testing must be done through the committee's official testing clinic. There will be 1 testing clinic date provided, does must be tested at this clinic in order to sell. Youth must make arrangements to get their doelings to the testing site. All CAE tests will be sent to Washington State University, by the Ferndale Veterinary Office and test results will be sent to the committee. If any follow-up testing need be done, it will be done through the committee at the Ferndale Veterinary office, and a negative test result must be received prior to Junior Livestock check in day. No does will be accepted in to the sale pens without a negative test result.
10. Original registration papers must be submitted to the Committee at the exhibitors meeting prior to the Auction.
11. Buyers shall pay the bank clerking the sale for their purchases immediately after the sale. Sellers must present a Thank You note and sign their papers prior to receiving their check. Checks will not be available until after the sale has concluded.
12. A 3.5% sale commission will be charged to defray the cost of promoting and conducting the auction.
13. A doe may be substituted prior to fair entry, upon the discretion of the committee. Additional documentation may be required by the committee as evidence for the substitution.
14. There is a mandatory exhibitors meeting at 9:00 am on the morning of the sale.
